Tyre depot hopes for wheel success

A NEW tyre depot opened on Monday creating four new jobs in the town.

Bush Tyres has opened in Cherry Holt Square, Cherry Holt Road, Bourne.

The Boston-based company's latest depot is the 14th of its kind and opened on the company's 60th anniversary of being in business.

Manager Steve Waterfall, who has worked for the company for 25 years, said: "We are conscious that in a time where many jobs are being cut, and businesses are contracting, we are expanding and creating jobs within the local community.

"We have serviced the Bourne customer base for many years at our Sleaford and Boston branches.

"The opening of our Bourne depot will enable us to service the Bourne people far more effectively.

"There are only four jobs at the moment but when the business expands there is potential for more and it is obviously very positive news for the town."

The site was previously occupied by a Bourne Golf Centre, which has relocated to another site in Cherry Holt Road.

The change of use was only approved by South Kesteven District Council in February and it has taken just two months to revamp the site.

The company plans to open another depot in Spalding later in the year.
